AND WHEREAS, the said ISAAC EDWARDS has paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale, and the laws of the State duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars, and all legal interest thereon accrued, as fully appears by the certificate of the proper officer, now on file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Utah;

NOW THEREFORE, I WILLIAM SPRY, GOVERNOR, in consideration of the premises, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, in such case made and provided, do issue this PATENT, in the name and by the authority of the State of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said ISAAC EDWARDS and to his heirs and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of Uintah, State aforesaid, to-wit:

The South East quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the North East quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the South Half (SH $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 24, and the North East quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the South East quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 31 in Township 3 North Range 17 East of the Salt Lake Meridian containing Four Hundred (400) acres according to the said certificate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described and granted premises unto the said ISAAC EDWARDS and to his heirs and assigns forever, subject to any easement or right of way of the public, to use all such highways as may have been established according to law, over the same, or any part thereof and subject also to all right of way for ditches, tunnels and telephone and transmission lines that may have been constructed by authority of the United States
