TRANSMISSION LINE EASEMENT

2. Walker Bank & Trust Company, a corporation, as Trustee under the will of William Harry Shearman Deceased, doing business in the State of Utah, Grantor, hereby conveys, and warrants to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, inspection, relocation and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution, telephone and telegraph circuits of the Grantee, and 1 three-pole and 3 two-pole towers and 7 guy anchors with the necessary guys, stubs, cross arms, braces and other attachments affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, on, under, over, through, and across a tract of land (50) feet in width, located in Salt Lake County, Utah, and being twenty-five (25) feet on each side of the following described center line:

Beginning on east boundary line of Grantor's land at west line of County Road at a point 1200 feet north and 33 feet west, more or less, from the southeast corner of Section 11, T. 1 S., R. 2 W., S.L.B. & M., thence running S. 51° 51' W. 1790 feet, more or less, thence S. 0° 09' E. 100 feet, more or less, to south boundary line of said land at north line of County Road and being in the S-1/2 of the SE 1/4 of said Section 11.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.
