- 3. Assignor warrants, to the best of their knowledge, that the Agreement is in full force and effect, and has not been modified or amended.
- Assignee harmless from all manners of suit, actions, damages, charges and expenses, including attorneys' fees and costs which Assignee may sustain by reason of Assignor's breach of any of the terms, covenants and conditions of the Agreement occurring prior to the date first above written.
- 5. Assignee hereby indemnifies and holds Assignor harmless from all manners of suit, actions, damages, charges and expenses including attorneys' fees and costs, which

Assignor may sustain by reason of Assignee's breach of any of the terms, covenants and conditions of the Agreement occurring after the date first above written.

6. This Assignment and Assumption of Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of Assignor and Assignee, and their respective heirs, successors, and assigns.




