To all to whom these presents shall come greeting

Whereas by the Acts of Congress approved July 1, 1862 and July 2, 1864 to and in the construction of a railroad and telegraph line from the Missouri River to the Pacific Ocean and to ascertain the Government the use of the same for postal military and other purposes authority is given to the Union Pacific Railroad Company to construct a railroad and telegraph line under certain conditions and stipulations as expressed in said acts and provisions is made for granting to the said company every alternate section of public land designated by odd numbers to the company of the alternate sections herewith on each side of the said railroad and the line thereon and within the limits of thirty miles on each side of said road not sold reserved or otherwise disposed of by the United States and to which a pre-emption or Homestead claim may not have attached at the time the land of said road is definitely fixed
