RIGHT OF WAY AND EASEMENT

STATE OF UTAH, by and through its DIVISION OF FACLITIES CONSTRUCTION AND MANAGEMENT, a division of the Department of Administrative Services, with its principal office at 4110 State Office Building in Salt Lake City, Utah, Grantor, hereby conveys and warrants to PACIFICORP, an Oregon Corporation, dba Utah Power and Light Company, whose principal place of business is located at 1407 West North Temple, Salt Lake City, Utah, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee for the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other valuable consideration an easement and right of way for the erection, operation, maintenance, repair, alteration, enlargement, inspection, relocation and replacement of electric transmissions and distribution lines, communications circuits, fiber optic cables and associated facilities for the support of said lines and circuits, on, over, under, and across real property located in Draper, Salt Lake County, Utah, described as follows:

Commencing from a point located on the center line of a 5-foot wide easement being two and one-half feet on each side of the following described survey line:

Beginning at a pole in an existing power line on the Grantor's land at a point 225 feet north and 161 feet west, more or less, from the east one quarter corner of Section 12, T.4 S., R. 1 W., S.L.M., thence Underground N.58°34'W. 95 feet, more or less, to a northwest boundary fence of the Grantor's land said fence also being the southeast right of way fence of I-15, being on said land and being in the SE ¼ of the NE ¼ of said Section 12.

Beginning at a pole in an existing power line on the Grantor's land at a point 473 feet north and 1467 feet west, more or less, from the east one quarter corner of Section 12, T.4 S., R. 1 W., S.L.M., thence S.58°34'E. 75 feet, more or less, to a southeast boundary fence of the Grantor's land said fence also being the northwest right of way fence of Interstate-15, being on said land and being in the SW ¼ of the NE ¼ of said Section 12.

GRANTOR reserves the right to occupy and use said property for all purposes not inconsistent with the rights herein granted and shall retain the full right, title, and possession of the property except for the limited easement granted herein.
