Whereas Augustus A. Carter of Salt Lake County Utah Territory has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City Utah Territory whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Augustus A. Carter according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands and the acts supplemental thereto, for the West half of the Northwest quarter of Section Fourteen and the North half of the Northwest quarter of Section Fifteen in Township three South of Range Two West of Salt Lake Meridian in Utah Territory, containing One Hundred and Eighty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Augustus A. Carter.

Now Know Ye, that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Augustus A. Carter and to his heirs, the said tract above described To Have and to Hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Augustus A. Carter and to his heirs and assigns forever, subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law: and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States. This patent is issued in lieu of an erroneous one dated November 9th 1871 which has been cancelled.
