And it appearing to the members of the Board of County Commissioners that the aforementioned persons are the owners of the land contained in the entire plat aforesaid and are the owners of all the land contiguous or adjacent to that portion of said property herein sought to be vacated. And it further appearing that said street or alley is ungraded and unimproved, and that neither the public nor any person will be materially injured by the said partial vacation of said plat. And it further appearing to the satisfaction of said Commission that said street or alley sought to be vacated by this petition has not had public money expended upon the same nor has the Legislature of the State of Utah appropriated or expended public money upon the same.
