# LAND USE AGREEMENT AND RESTRICTIVE COVENANT

AN AGREEMENT made this \_\_ISTH\_\_ day of SEPT, 1992, by and between the Salt Lake County Water Conservancy District ("District"), a water conservancy district with its principal offices at 8215 South 1300 West, West Jordan, Utah 84084, and Waterford Institute, Inc.("Waterford"), a Delaware Corporation doing business in Utah with its address at 1480 East 9400 South, Sandy, Utah, 84093, owner of the property described in this Agreement. For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

#### WITNESETH:

1. Waterford is the owner of the following described tract of land located at 1530 East 9400 South, Salt Lake County, Utah, and more particularly described as:

A 100.00 foot radius Well Protection Zone with the Center radius point being North 89°53'28" East 1358.37 feet and South 00°13'23" West 93.00 feet from the Northwest Corner of Section 9, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian;

hereinafter the "protected zone property."

- 2. The District is the owner of adjacent property to the property described above.
- 3. Waterford covenants and agrees not to locate or permit concentrated sources of pollution within the protected zone property described in paragraph 1. The term "concentrated

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sources of pollution" includes septic tanks, drain fields, garbage dumps, pit privies, drain lines, sewer lines, corrals, feed lots, and all other similar structures and uses. This Covenant shall run with the land described above, and is binding upon the owners, and owners' heirs, successors, and assigns.
