... Dollars, in consideration of which the undersigned hereby grants to the American Telephone and Telegraph Company, its associated and allied companies, its and their respective successors, assigns, lessees and licensees, the right to enter upon, across, over and under the land of the undersigned, to construct, operate, maintain, replace and remove a communication system consisting of such poles, towers, anchors, wires, cables, testing terminals, conduits, manholes, markers and other appurtenances, at the greater or lesser height or to times required, upon, across, over and under the land which the undersigned own or in which he or she or they have an interest in the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 11, Township 1 North, Range 1 West, the location of said right of way and easement being along the North Boundary line of the above described land, and extending not more than fifty feet from the said boundary line.

... County of **DAVIS**, State of **Utah**.  
and upon, across, over and under the roads, streets and highways adjoining the said land, together with all rights, powers and privileges over and across the lands of the undersigned to and from said system for the purpose of extending the right of the Grantees to install poles in any trees crossing said system; to cut down and keep cut down all trees and undergrowth which may interfere with or damage any trees that may reach said system in failing; to permit the attachment of and to carry in and out of said system wires, cables, circuits and appurtenances of any other company; and, when said system is located on the highway, to permit the system to permit highway widening. The undersigned for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, hereby covenant that no impenetrable structure shall be erected or permitted on said land which will interfere with the Grantees' right to lay for damage to fences and growing crops arising from the construction and maintenance of the system. This instrument is to replace that certain Grant of Right of Way made by the undersigned on May 1, 1931, recorded in Book 1 of Grants of Rights of Way, page 10, and to release and limit the location of the roadway and the placement as herein described.
