Whereas The Heirs of John Clyde, of Wasatch County

has appeared in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City, Utah whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Heirs of John Clyde

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 22d of April 1850, entitled "An Act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands" and the act supplemental thereto for the West half of the North East quarter, the East half of the North West quarter, the North West quarter of the South East quarter and the North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section ten in Township three North of Range five East of Salt Lake Meridian in Utah, containing two hundred and forty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said Tract has been purchased by the said Heirs of John Clyde

Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and amended HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT unto the said Heirs of John Clyde

and to their heirs the said Tract above described TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereto belonging unto the said Heirs of John Clyde

and to their heirs and assigns forever, subject to any vested and unvested water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a mine or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted as provided by law. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way therein for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States

President of the United States of America has caused these letters to be with Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed

Given under my hand at the City of Washington the thirtieth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety three and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and thirty seventh
