Witnesseth, that the said first parties for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars to them in hand paid by the said second party, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, give and grant unto the said second party, and to its successors, the right to construct, operate and maintain, its Gravity Outlet Sewer through the following described premises, to-wit:
