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AN ORDINANCE
AN ORDINANCE VACATING an alley at approximately 119 Cornell Street, Salt Lake City, Utah.
Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Salt Lake City, Utah:

SECTION 1. That that alley located at approximately 119 Cornell Street, more particularly described as follows, be, and the same hereby is, vacated and declared no longer to be public property for use as a street, avenue, alley or pedestrian way:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot 1, Block 2, Agricultural Park Plat "B" Sub., located in Southeast quarter or Section 34, Township 1 North, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian and running thence West 185 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 7 of said subdivision, thence North 15 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 8 of said subdivision, thence East 185 feet to the Southeast corner of said Lot 8, thence South 15 feet to the point of beginning. Contains 0.064 Acres.

Said vacation is made expressly subject to all existing rights of way and easements of all public utilities located in, on or under the confines of the above described property, and also subject to the rights of entry thereon for the purpose of maintaining, repairing, replacing, removing, altering or rerouting said utilities and all of them.

SECTION 2. In the opinion of the Board of Commissioners it is necessary to the peace, health and welfare of the Inhabitants of Salt Lake City that this ordinance become effective immediately.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its first publication.
