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Arnold W. Bosworth and Gertrude S. Bosworth

his wife, Grantor.S, in supplement to that certain Transmission Line Easement dated the 18th day of April, 1914 and recorded as Entry No. 15286C in the Office of the County Recorder of Box Elder County, State of Utah, in Book E of Misc.

at Page 415, for and in consideration of One hundred Dollars, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, together with the consideration specified in said Transmission Line Easement for an additional line, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and warrant to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, Grantee, its successors and assigns, a perpetual easement and right of way for the construction, erection, operation and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, inspection, relocation, and/or replacement of a wood pole or steel tower line or lines, for the transmission, distribution, telegraph and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and

wood structure(s), together with necessary cross-arms and attachments, with no guys including stubs and anchors, affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, in, upon, along, over, through, across and/or under a tract of land 150 feet in width, situated in the County of

Box Elder, State of Utah, as described in the above referenced Transmission Line Easement, and along a center line described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a fence on the south boundary line of the grantor's land at a point 1350 feet north and 900 feet east, more or less, from the south one quarter corner of Section 4, T. 9 N., R. 2 W., S.L.M., thence N. 9°10' W. 620 feet to a fence on the north boundary line of said land and being in the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of said Section 4.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.

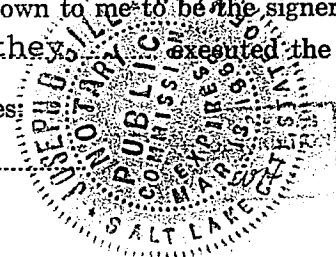
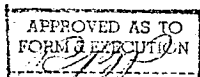
