No. 90502 RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED

Joseph Payne and Ada J. Payne, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of \$10.00 and other good and valuable consideration, do hereby grant and convey unto the Utah State Department of Fish and Game the following described right-of-way for a road and other purposes across what is now known as the "Joseph Payne farm" located in West Kaysville, Davis County, Utah. Said right-of-way being described as follows, to-wit:

Lying in Sections 5, 8 and 9, Township 3 North, Range 1 West.

Commencing at the West gate post of a field gate, the same being 66 feet approximately due North of the Joseph Payne flowing well, running thence Southwesterly 1060 feet more or less, thence Southeasterly 489 feet, thence Northeasterly 25 feet, thence Northwesterly 464 feet, thence Northeasterly 1035 feet, thence Northwesterly 25 feet to point of beginning. It being agreed that the grantee will install and maintain necessary fences and water culverts to protect the remaining estate. Located in Kaysville, Davis County, State of Utah.
