Received of THE AMERICAN TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY OF WYOMING Two Hundred Fifty & 50/100 DOLLARS (\$250.00), in consideration of which SALT LAKE COUNTY, a body corporate and politic of the State of Utah, Grantor, does hereby grant, convey, release and quitclaim unto said Company, its associates and allied companies, its and their respective successors, assigns, lessors and agents, a right of way and easement to construct, operate, maintain, replace and remove such communication systems as the grantees may from time to time require, consisting of underground cables, wires, conduits, manholes, drains and splicing boxes, surface testing terminals, repeaters and markers, and other appurtenances, upon, over and under a strip of land one rod wide across the land which the undersigned owns or in which it has or may have any interest in the County of Salt Lake and State of Utah within the following described Sections, to wit:
