~~his wife~~ Grantor, of Salt Lake County, Utah, hereby convey^s and warrant^s to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and no guy anchors and one poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, crossarms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Salt Lake County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Beginning at the north boundary line of the Grantors' land at a point 97 feet north and one foot east, more or less, from the southwest corner of Lot 5, Block 4, 10 Acre Plat "A" Big Field Survey, thence S. 0° 04' W. 118 feet, more or less, to the south boundary line of said land and being in said Lot 5 and Lot 4 of said Block 14, also being in Lot 3, Block 4, Section 36, T. 1 S., R. 1 W., S.L.M.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.
