

repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and one poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantors, in Salt Lake County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Commencing on the West boundary of Grantor's land 2080 feet West of a point 2195 feet North of the Southeast corner, Section 36, Township 1, South, Range 1, West, S. L. M. - thence running South $71^{\circ} 31'$ East 215 feet to East boundary of Grantor's land; all contained within the Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, said Township and Range.

Together with full right of ingress and egress for all purposes of maintenance, inspection, repair, alteration and replacement of said circuits, supports and attachments.


