Notice of Adoption of Final Redevelopment Plan  
for the 36th Street Redevelopment Project,  
Project Area No. 2 of the Redevelopment Agency of  
South Ogden, Utah

Pursuant to Section 17A-2-1257, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended, the following information is recorded in the office of the Recorder of Weber County:

1. Description of the Land within the Project Area as Amended.

Beginning at the North City limits of South Ogden City and the Northeast intersection of 36th Street and Washington Boulevard continuing South approximately 725 feet more or less along the east side of Washington Boulevard to the Southeast intersection of 37th Street and Washington Boulevard, thence West along the South side of 37th Street 1230 feet more or less to the North side of Riverdale Road, thence along the North side of Riverdale Road to the North City limits of South Ogden City, and 36th Street; thence East along the North City limits of South Ogden City and 36th Street 780 feet more or less to the point of beginning contains approximately 11.2 acres of privately owned property.

2. Statement that the Final Redevelopment Plan for the 36th Street Redevelopment Project has been approved.

The City Council of South Ogden, adopted and approved the final Redevelopment Plan for the 36th Street Redevelopment Project Area by ordinance at its November 24, 1992 City Council Meeting.

3. Date of Approval

The final Redevelopment Plan for the 36th Street Redevelopment Project Area was approved on November 24, 1992, and became effective on the date the ordinance was posted by the South Ogden City Recorder.
