POLE LINE EASEMENT

ILLINOIS POWDER MFG. COMPANY, a corporation doing business in the State of Utah, Grantor, hereby conveys and warrants to **UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY**, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and one guy anchor and four poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Utah County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Beginning on west boundary line of grantor's land at east fence of State Highway at a point 2430 feet south and 1490 feet west, more or less, from the northeast corner of Section 34, T.8 S., R.3 E., S.L.B.& M., thence running S.88°21' E. 488 feet on said land; including existing 2-pole extension to original 4-pole switchrack; also including operating area fifty by fifty feet extending North 25 feet, East 17 feet, South 25 feet and West 33 feet, from center of 4-pole switchrack; and being in the S 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of said Section 34.

This Easement will cancel and supersede that certain Easement granted by the same Grantors December 16, 1942, and recorded as Entry No. 7867 July 27, 1943, in the records of Utah County Recorder in Book 377 at page 550-1.

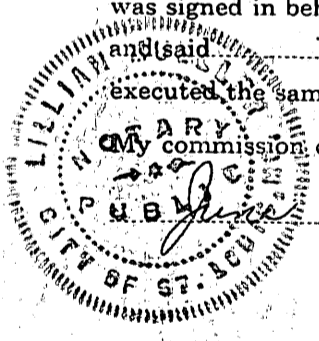

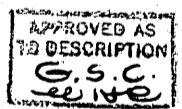
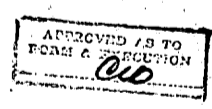
