WHEREAS, on July 9, 1942, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting by and through the War Department (hereinafter called the Government), and the City Water Service of Salt Lake City, Utah, (hereinafter called the City), entered into Contract W-2195-ENG-252, whereby the Government would construct a water pipe line at its own expense, from Samuel C. Park Reservoir to Air Corps Replacement Center, Kearns, Utah; and

WHEREAS, the City agreed to furnish water to the Government through the aforesaid pipeline, at a stipulated rate, the value of water so furnished to be credited by the Government against the cost of the pipeline until paid for; and

WHEREAS, it was agreed that the Government would sell the said pipeline to the City at the termination of the emergency for the sum of One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (125,000.00), less that sum which has been credited as a result of the water furnished to the Government by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has credited on the purchase price, the sum of One Hundred Four Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-four and 06/100 Dollars, (\$104,524.06), that being the value of the water furnished the Government,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$125,000.00), of which One Hundred Four Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-four and 06/100 Dollars (\$104,524.06) has been credited by water furnished, and a cash payment of Twenty Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-five and 94/100 Dollars (\$20,475.94), in hand paid by the City, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

acting by and through War Assets Administrator, pursuant to Reorganization Plan No. of 1947 (38 F. R. 4534), Surplus Property Act of 1944, and applicable rules and regulations, does hereby assign, transfer and set over unto said City of Salt Lake City, Utah, all the right, title and interest, in and to:

That certain pipe line extending from the Samuel G. Park Reservoir of the City of Salt Lake across the Jordan River Valley to the cantonment site on the Western side of the valley. Pipe consisting of 16" o.d. x 5/16" seamless steel with welded joints and coal-tar enamel coating, the pipe occupying a position approximately 18 feet South of the highway center-line and having a minimum cover of 3 feet.

Commencing at a connection to an existing 24" x 12" cast iron tee approximately 50 feet southwest of the City of Salt Lake Samuel G. Park Reservoir outlet and extending in a Southwesterly direction to a point 14.93 feet North of the Southwest corner of property owned by the city, thence approximately South 26° 12' West and entering the State Highway (3300 South Street) at a point 50 feet North of the center line thereof and approximately 2718 feet East of the center line of 2700 East Street, and continuing South 26° 12' West to a point 13 feet South of the center line of 3300 South Street at a station approximately 2580 feet East of the center line of 2700 East Street.

Thence due West along 3300 South Street, 13 feet South of the center line, with a minimum depth of 3 feet, crossing all intersecting highways within the limits of the herein grant, and crossing under all canals, ditches, and conduits, and maintaining this location 13 feet South of the center line wherever possible. Offsets to the South will be necessary to clear the Jordan and Salt Lake Canal and the Millcreek bridge.

At a point opposite the center line of Eldridge Street the pipe line is to deviate South and following a right of way approximately parallel with the boundary of the State Highway, pass around the D. & R.G.W.R.R. underpass and under the railroad right of way approximately 45 feet South of the center line of 3300 South Street, thence deviating North past the North edge of the underpass pumping house and again taking up a line 13 feet South of the center line of 3300 South Street at a point approximately 400 feet West of the center line of Fourth West Street.


Thence West, following the State Highway on 3300 South Street, maintaining a position approximately 13 feet South of the center line to the Jordan River bridge.

From the Jordan River bridge the pipe line extends West, passing to the South of the Jordan Canal culvert with a grade to insure passing under the canal flow-line. Following the curve of the State highway and maintaining a position 18 feet South of the center line, the pipe line extends West along 3500 South Street to 4800 West Street, thence around a 90° bend, leaving the State Highway, and maintaining a position 13 feet East of the center line of 4800 West Street, the line extending South to the North boundary of 4700 South Street, thence through a 35° Westerly offset, the line extending diagonally across the intersection of 4700 South Street and 4800 West Street to the North boundary of the cantonment.


