The above entitled action coming on duly and regularly to be heard, Messrs. Van Cott, Allison, Riter and Barkness and C. S. Varian appearing as attorneys for the plaintiffs, and Messrs. Liggins and Jones appearing for the defendants S. C. Sudbury and Melvin C. Cook, and testimony having been duly introduced and considered, and findings of fact and conclusions of law having been made and filed herein, now therefore, in consideration of the premises, it is ordered, adjudged and decreed:

That this court has jurisdiction of all of said defendants as appears by proof on file herein; that the title of said plaintiffs is hereby confirmed and quieted against said defendants; except as hereinafter mentioned, to the Ridgeland or Job Lawrence Canal, which canal is situated in Salt Lake County, Utah, and described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the S. E. 1/4 of the S. E. 1/4, Sec. 20 T. 1 S. R. 1 W. which bears from S. W. corner Sec. 18, T. 1 S. R. 1 W. S. 84 degrees 00 minutes E. 10370.9 feet to said point, being the center of the headgate through which the water is diverted into the canal from the 5th District Ditch, and running thence N. 89 degrees 49 minutes W. 1099 feet, thence N. 47 degrees 35 minutes W. 165 feet, thence N. 27 degrees 45 minutes W. 317 feet, thence N. 0 degrees 12 minutes E. 1102 feet, thence N. 56 degrees 25 minutes W. 697 feet, thence N. 89 degrees 40 minutes W. 2187 feet, thence N. 89 degrees 37 minutes W. 1280 feet, thence N. 50 degrees 32 minutes W. 83 feet, thence N. 0 degrees 18 minutes E. 1245 feet, thence N. 80 degrees 20 minutes W. 131.5 feet, thence N. 89 degrees 53 minutes W. 2100 feet, thence N. 89 degrees 00 minutes W. 1778 feet, thence N. 0 degrees 53 minutes E. 1200 feet, thence N. 0 degrees 33 minutes E. 1550 feet, thence N. 0 degrees 53 minutes E. 1500 feet, thence N. 1 degree

The said canal is owned by the following persons in the following proportions, to-wit: Wm. C. Fox, as Trustee of an express trust, an undivided  $\frac{4}{99}$ ; Anna W. Lowe an undivided one-sixth; Abner W. Ewing, as administratrix of the estate of Samuel C. Ewing, deceased, an undivided one-sixth.

S. C. Sudbury had a right to condemn or enlarge said canal sufficiently to carry his quantity of water from the headgate of the 5th <sup>Ditch</sup> District, to his intake by paying proper compensation, it was agreed, at the conclusion of the trial, that S. C. Sudbury by paying  $\$7.50$  should be adjudicated to be the owner of  $\frac{97}{1186}$  of said Ridgeland or Job Lawrence Canal from said headgate to the point of his intake; and S. C. Sudbury having paid said sum, he is now hereby decreed to be the owner of an undivided  $\frac{97}{1186}$  of said Ridgeland or Job Lawrence Canal from the said headgate to the point of his intake. The said plaintiffs are entitled to recover their costs of court herein.
