Pole Line Easement

1. Woods Cross Canning Co., a corporation doing business in the State of Utah, hereby conveys and warrants to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 2 guys and 2 poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Davis County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Beginning on north fence line of Grantor's land at a point 100 ft. south and 50 ft. east, more or less, from the west quarter corner of Sec. 1, T. 4 N., R. 2 W., S. 1. B&M., thence running southeasterly parallel to O. S. L. R. R. 341 ft. on said land and being in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ said Sec. 1. Excepting from the above the Right of Way of the O. S. L. R. R. Company.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.
