The corners of the land mentioned in and shown on annexed plat of South Salt Lake do hereby grant and convey unto the County of Salt Lake the land herein designated as streets and alleys to be used as public thoroughfares forever. A correct description of said property by metes and bounds is as follows commencing at a point 59 feet E. 100 feet South of the corner to sections 13, 24, 25 & 26 Township 22 N. Range 10 E. and running thence West 750 feet thence North 77 1/4 feet. Thence East 750 feet thence South 77 1/4 feet to place of beginning containing 12 1/2 acres of land. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this day of April 1890.

I hereby certify that the annexed plat of South Salt Lake is true and correct said subdivision being situated on Lots 2, 3 and the South half of Lot 4 - One acre Plat A, and described by metes and bounds in the above dedication of streets. The same being 77 1/4 feet North and South and 750 feet East and West. Blocks One and Two are each 705 feet long and 250 feet wide with a 25 feet alley running North and South 550 feet and a 25 feet alley running East and West 313 1/2 feet. In Blocks 1 and 2 lots numbered from 1 to 22 inclusive and from 26 to 58 inclusive are each 25 x 125 feet and lots numbered from 24 to 58 inclusive are each 25 x 130 feet. Lots 2, 3 and 4 are 100 feet wide. A 12 1/2 feet alley runs East and West along the north line of each Block. Center Street is 66 feet East and West and 717 1/2 feet South and North. East Temple Street is 66 feet wide x 717 1/2 feet long, being one half the width of said street West Temple Street joins this property on the west.
