AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING 2700 WEST AS
CONSTITUTION BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, Section 10-8-32, UCA, (1953) as amended, sets forth the authority of the City to change the name of streets within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, 1987 marks the bicentennial celebration of the U.S. Constitution; and

WHEREAS, certain property along 2700 West in West Valley City has been chosen as the site for the government center of West Valley City; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of promoting patriotism among the residents of West Valley City and recognizing the future location of the new City Hall as the government center of West Valley City, the City Council has determined that 2700 West between 2100 South and 4700 South should be also named "Constitution Boulevard"; and

WHEREAS, due to the foregoing the City Council is satisfied that there is good cause for such name change, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and that it should be made.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of West Valley City, Utah as follows:

Section 1. 2700 West, between 2100 South and 4700 South shall henceforth be also known and designated as "Constitution Boulevard".

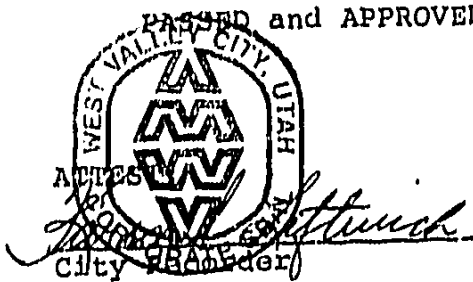
Section 2. The City Recorder is hereby directed to record this ordinance with the Salt Lake County Recorder's Office.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and posting, as required by law.
