

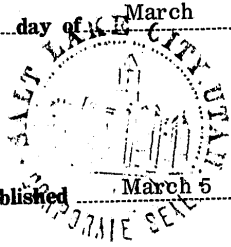

AN ORDINANCE VACATING Fern Avenue between West Capitol and Wall Streets.
Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Salt Lake City, UTAH:
SECTION 1. The Fern Avenue between West Capitol and Wall Streets, commencing at the intersection of the same hereby is vacated and declared no longer to be public property, for use as a way, avenue, alley or pedestrian way.
Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 5, Block 22, Plat 29827, Salt Lake County, East 798.72 feet; thence North 45.70 feet around a 40 foot radius curve to the intersection of the same with N 22 degrees 24' 08" W. at the point of beginning; thence West 327.84 feet to the intersection of the same with thence S 53 degrees 46' 50.70 feet to the point of beginning.
Said vacation is made expressly subject to all public utilities and easements of all public utilities of any and every description now located on, over or under the property, and also subject to the rights of entry, thereon for the purpose of installing, maintaining, repairing, removing, altering or reworking said utilities and all of them, of Companies, persons or entities duly licensed and assessed by Salt Lake City, Utah, this 28th day of February, 1968.
