One Hundred and No/100 Dollars, in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telephone and Telegraph, including the necessary poles, cables, wires and fixtures upon, over and across the property which I own, or in which I have any interest, in the West half of the Northeast quarter and in the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter and in the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 5 East of the Salt Lake Meridian. County of Summit and State of Utah with the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, and the right to trim any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires cleared at least forty-eight inches, to erect and set the necessary anchors and to attach thereto the necessary guy wires.
