This Indenture made on this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of January 1904, between  
The Utah Light & Power Company a corporation of Utah, party of the first  
part, and the Utah Light & Railway Company a corporation of Utah, party

Witnesseth, that whereas at a meeting of the Stockholders held at the office of the Utah Light & Power Company on December 18<sup>th</sup>, 1903, it was unanimously voted to authorize the President and Secretary, to deed and transfer all of the property of the Utah Light & Power Company including its rights and franchises of every nature and kind, to a new corporation to be formed under the name and style of the Utah Light & Railway Company; and that afterwards, namely, on the 30<sup>th</sup> of December 1903, the Board of Directors of the Utah Light & Power Company, met and ratified the action of the Stockholders, and there and then authorized and directed the President and Secretary to execute a deed conveying all the property, rights and franchises of the Utah Light & Power Company to the Utah Light & Rail- way Company.

Now Therefore This Indenture Witnesseth, That the Utah Light  
& Power Company party of the first part, in consideration of the premises  
and a further consideration of 3,162,000 shares of the Capital Stock of the

Utah Light & Railway Company, has granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents does bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second part its executors and assigns forever, all of the electrical and gas plants of the party of the first part, which includes all of its power plants, power houses, water and steam power, station houses, pole and wire lines in the Counties of Weber, Davis and Salt Lake, together with all franchises, rights and privileges of every nature and kind, except the right to be a corporation, which is reserved to the party of the first part.


