Grantor, of Salt Lake County, Utah, hereby convey and warrant to WHITE OXYGEN COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and one guy anchor and poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, crossarms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the supports of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Salt Lake County, Utah,

along a line described as follows: Beginning at corner of west line of county road and east boundary line of grantor's lot as a point 21 feet south and 22 feet west, more or less, from the northeast corner of section 33, T. 33.2.12, S. 4. E. 4 N, the ea running N. 89.0000' E. 120.00 feet, more or less, to the west boundary line of said land and being in the N. 1/4 of the S. 1/4 of said section 33. To describe this easement it is understood that said line will be constructed and maintained in accordance with the National Safety Code. It is further understood that in case of construction work being done under said line poles will be moved in line to accommodate same.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.
