ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER

I, Mildred G. Snider, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment, and that on the 7th day of August, 1978, Case No. 7246 - Reopened - by Ft. Douglas-Hidden Valley Country Club, Nathan B. Hale, club manager, was heard by the Board. The applicant requested consideration of the length of time which constitutes the winter months for the purpose of of the installation of the bubble over the tennis courts at 2 Medical Drive and to legalize the height of the bubble as constructed, which varies from 20 to 40 feet above grade, in a Residential "R-1" District, the legal description of said property being as follows:

Commencing N 89°58'03" E 1757.44 feet and N 0°01'18" E 661.64 feet and N 89°58'03" E 865.74 feet from the Southeast corner of Lot 12, Block 8, Popperton Place, running N 0°01'57" W 456.70 feet; N 89°58'03" E 450.0 feet; S 0°01'57" E 456.70 feet; S 89°58'03" W 450.0 feet to the point of beginning, being in S½ Sec. 33, T1N, R1E, SLB&M.

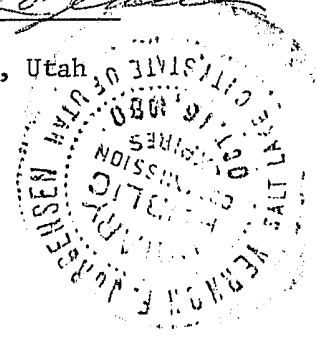
