RIGHT OF WAY DEED

RAYMOND H. OSTLER and VONEAL I. OSTLER, his wife, Grantors, of Nephi, Juab County, State of Utah, hereby grant and convey unto ARTHUR G. OSTLER, Grantee, of the same place, for the sum of One dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, a right of way and easement for the purposes hereinafter set forth over and upon the following described tracts of land situate in Juab County, State of Utah, to-wit:

The Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 17, Township 12 South, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Meridian. Also, beginning at the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of said Section 17, thence East 23 rods, thence South 140 rods, thence East 137 rods, thence South 20 rods, thence West 160 rods, thence North 160 rods to the place of beginning. Containing in all 79.625 acres, more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said right of way and easement unto the said Grantee, his heirs, personal representatives and assigns, for the purpose of ingress and egress by vehicular travel and for driving livestock over the roadway as now existing or as may hereafter be designated by the grantors from the highway now known and designated as U. S. Highway No. 91 to and from the following described tract/land situate in Juab County, State of Utah, to-wit:

Beginning 48 rods North of the Southeast corner of Section 18, Township 12 South, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Meridian, thence North 48 rods; thence West 100 rods; thence South 48 rods; thence East 100 rods to the place of beginning. Containing 30 acres.

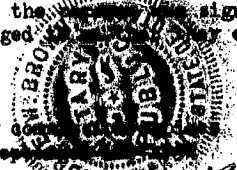
