W.M.Boyden and Annie Boyden,his wife, Grantors, of Coalville, Summit County, Utah, hereby quit claim to THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, its successors and assigns, acting pursuant to the provisions of the Act of June 17, 1902 (32 Stat.,388), and acts amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto, Grantee, for the sum of Fifty and no/hundredths Dollars (\$50.00), the following described tract of land in Summit County, State of Utah, to-wit:

A tract of land situated in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Seventeen (17), Township Two (2) North, Range Five (5) East, S.L.B.& M., and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point which bears North 88°10' West Eight Hundred Six and Eight-tenths (806.8) Feet from the north quarter corner of said Section Seventeen (17); running thence North 88°10' West Eleven (11.0) Feet; thence South 6°56' East Two Hundred Forty (240.0) Feet; thence South 18°50' East Five Hundred Two (502.0) Feet; thence South 28°16' East One Hundred Ninety and Six-tenths (190.6) Feet; thence North 1°12' East One Hundred Seventy-eight (178.0) Feet; thence North 21°18' West Seven Hundred Fifty-four and Three-tenths (754.3) Feet to the point of beginning, and containing 1.34 acres, more or less.

QUIT CLAIM DEED

UTAH BOND & SHARE COMPANY, a corporation of Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, State of Utah, hereby quit claims to GUS P. BACKMAN of the same place for the sum of \$10.00, the following described Property in Summit County:

All its right, title and interest in and to Sections 5 and 6, in Township 2 North of Range 5 East of the Salt Lake Meridian; all its right, title and interest in and to Section 25 in Township 3 North of Range 4 East of the Salt Lake Meridian; and all its right, title and interest in and to Sections 29, 30, 31 and 32 in Township 3 North of Range 5 East of the Salt Lake Meridian.

Together with all water and water rights, canals, reservoir, reservoir and power sites, in and to the waters of the Weber River and its tributaries, and appurtenant and incident to the above described premises, or which have been used in any manner in connection therewith, including all rights acquired by use, purchase or gift, and covering both recorded rights and those based upon appropriation and use, and all rights in any manner thereto appertaining or belonging.
