Taylor, the administration tratrix of the estate above-named, coming on regularly to be heard, and upon the proofs adduced it appearing to this court that notice of this hearing was duly given as required by law; that the above-named, George Arnold Taylor, Deceased, entered into an agreement in writing to convey the respective parcels of real estate hereinafter described to the said Dean Taylor and Glen Horton upon certain conditions; that said Dean Taylor and Glen Horton have duly performed all of the conditions required of them to be performed by the terms of said contract, and that they are entitled to a conveyance of said premises according to the terms of said agreement;

It is ordered, adjudged, and decreed that Hazel M. Taylor, as administratrix of the estate of George Arnold Taylor, Deceased, be, and she is hereby, required specifically to perform said agreement by executing to Dean Taylor and Glen Horton conveyances of the following described real property, conveying said real property to said parties in the following manner, to wit:

To Dean Taylor, the real property in Utah County, State of Utah, particularly described as follows, to wit:

"Commencing at a point 52.63 chains west of the northeast corner of Section 4, Township 7 South, Range 2 East of the Salt Lake Base and Meridian; thence south 14.85 chains; thence west to the shore of Utah Lake; thence northerly along the shore of Utah Lake to the north line of Section 5, said township and range; thence east along the north line of said Section 5 and the north line of said Section 4 to the place of beginning, together with a right-of-way to be selected."
