ORDINANCE NO. 40-87 MICKUTILMEN Robert H. DeBoer

AN ORDINANCE OF OGDEN CITY ADOPTING A REDEVELOPMENT PLAN AS OFFICIAL REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE PROJECT AREA DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Part of Section 29, Township 6 North, Range 1 West, of the S Lake Base and Meridian Survey, comprising all of Block 34, part of Block 23 of Plat "A" of Ogden City, Weber County, Utah. of the Salt 34. and

Beginning at the point of intersection of West right-of-way line of Wall Avenue, and North right-of-way line of 23rd Street, said point being North 89 degrees 02 minutes West *40.50 feet, and North *49.50 0 degrees 58 minutes East 49.50 feet from the Ogden City Honument Number 41, located at the intersection of Wall Avenue and 23rd Street. Thence, running the following course:

DESCRIBING THE PURPOSES AND INTENT OF THE COUNCIL WITH RESPECT TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PROJECT AREA; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE, DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE LINCOLN REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA, D DESIGNAT-ING THE APPROVED PLAN AS THE OFFICIAL REDEVELOPMENT PLAN OF THE PROJECT AREA; FINDING AND DECLARING THAT A PLAN WAS ADOPTED BY THE REDEVELOP-AREA; FINDING AND DECLARING THAT A PLAN WAS ADOPTED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND APPROVED, AND RECOMMENDED FOR APPROVAL BY THE OGDEN CITY PLANNING COMMISSION; THAT 7 PUBLIC HEARING WAS HELD BY THE CITY COUNCIL AS REQUIRED BY LAW AFTER LEGAL NOTICE; THAT THE PROJECT AREA IS A BLIGHTED AREA, THE REDEVELOPMENT OF WHICH IS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE PUBLIC PURPOSES OF THE UTAH NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT ACT; THAT THE PEDEVELOPMENT PLAN HOULD REDEVELOP THE AREA IN CONFORMITY WITH SAID ACT; THAT THE ADOPTION AND CARRYING OUT OF THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN IS SOUND AND REASONABLE; THAT THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN CONFORMS TO THE MASTER PLAN OF OGDEN CITY: THAT THE CARRYING OUT OF THE REDEVELOPMENT MASTER PLAN OF OGDEN CITY; THAT THE CARRYING OUT OF THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN WOULD PROMOTE THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH AND WELFARE OF THE COMMUNITY; THAT THE CONDEMNATION OF REAL PROPERTY, IF ANY, PROVIDED FOR IN THE PLAN IS NECESSARY TO THE EXECUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN AND ADEQUATE PROVISIONS HAVE BEEN MADE FOR PAYMENT OF PROPERTY, IF ANY, TO BE ACQUIRED AS PROVIDED BY LAW; THAT THE AGENCY HAS A FEASIBLE METHOD OR PLAY FOR RELOCATING PERSONS OR FAMILIES DISPLACED FROM THE PROJECT

AREA, IF ANY, DISPLACEMENTS OCCUR; THAT THERE ARE, OR WILL BE PROVIDED IN OTHER AREAS, NOT GENERALLY LESS DESIRABLE AT RENTS OR PRICES WITHIN THE FINANCIAL MEANS OF THE DISPLACED PERSONS OF FAMILIES, IF ANY, ADEQUATE HOUSING; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE TWENTY (20) DAYS AFTER PUBLICATION AFTER FINAL PASSAGE.

The Council of Ogden City hereby ordains;

SECTION 1. Redevelopment Plan for Lincoln Redevelopment Project Area. The Council finds and determines that the Ogden Neighborhood Development Agency prepared and adopted a Redevelopment Plan for the development of the Lincoln Redevelopment Project Area which was submitted to the Ogden City Council on the 16th day of April, 1987.

The Council further finds that the Redevelopment Plan was submitted to the Ogden City Planning Commission which recommended the approval of the plan.

The Council further finds that it held a public hearing on the plan at this regular council meeting on the 21st day of May, 1987 and that notice of the filing of the Redevelopment Plan and the public hearing thereon had been given as provided by law. The Council further finds that at said hearing the Council considered the report of the development agency together with the rules governing participation, and all testimony for and against the adoption of the plan.

SECTION 2. Redevelopment Plan Adopted. The Redevelopment Plan together with the report and rules governing participation, submitted by the development agency on the 16th day of April, 1987 and hereby approved and adopted as the official Redevelopment Plan of the project area is more particularly described as follows:

Part of Section 29, Township 6 North, Range 1 West, of the Salt Lake Base and Meridian Survey, comprising all of Block 34, and part of Block 23 of Plat "A" of Ogden City, Weber County, Utah.

Beginning at the point of intersection of West right-of-way line of Wall Avenue, and North right-of-way line of 23rd Street, said *49.50point being North 89 degrees 02 minutes West*40.59 feet, and North 0 degrees 58 minutes East 49.50 feet from the Ogden City Monument Number 41, located at the intersection of Wall Avenue and 23rd Street. Thence, running the following course:

South 89 degrees 02 minutes East 864.00 feet on the North right-of-way line of 23rd Street, thence South 0 degrees 58 minutes West 500.60 feet on the East right-of-way line of Lincoln Avenue, thence North 89 degrees 02 minutes West 99.00 feet to the West right-of-way line of Lincoln Avenue, thence on the said line South 0 degrees 58 minutes West 883.39 feet to the North right-of-way line of Depot Alley, thence on the said line North 89 degrees 02 minutes West*437-10 feet, thence South 0 degrees 58 minutes West 12 31 feet, thence North 89 degrees 02 minutes West 332.90 feet to the West right-of-way line of Wall Avenue, thence on the said line North 0 degrees 58 minutes East 1,396.30 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 25.54 acres.

SECTION 3. The purpose and intent of the Ogden City Council with respect to the project area is hereby determined to be the carrying out of the Redevelopment Plan hereby adopted so as to remove the blighted condition of the project area and to otherwise fully promote the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the community in general and the project area in particular.

SECTION 4. The Redevelopment Plan, as modified and so adopted, is hereby made a part of the ordinance by reference, and copies thereof are available for public inspection and use in the office of the Ogden City Recorder.

SECTION 5. The Council hereby finds and determines, upon the facts known to it and upon the facts and testimony submitted to it at the public hearing:

- (a) The project area is a blighted area, the redevelopment of which is necessary to effectuate the public purposes of the Utah Neighborhood Development Act, as set forth in Utah Code Annotated, Section 11-9-1, et. seq.
- (b) The Redevelopment Flan would redevelop the area in conformity with the Utah Neighborhood Development Act and in the interest of the public peace, health, safety and welfare.
- (c) The adoption and carrying out of the Redevelopment Plan is economically sound and feasible.
- (d) The Redevelopment Plan conforms to the master plan of the community.
- (e) The carrying out of the Redevelopment Plan would promote the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the community and would effectuate the purposes and policy of the Utah Neighborhood Development Act.
 - (f) The agency has a feasible method and plan for the relocation of families and persons temporarily or permanently displaced from housing facilities in the project area.
 - (g) There are, or, are being provided in other areas not generally less desirable in regard to public utilities and public and commercial facilities and at rents or prices within the financial means of the families and persons displaced from the project area, decent, safe, and sanitary dwellings equal in number to the number of and available to such displaced families and persons and reasonably accessible to their places of employment.

SECTION 6. The City Council is satisfied permanent housing facilities, if any be required, will be available within three years from the time occupants are displaced, and that adequate temporary housing facilities, at comparable rents, are presently available in the community.

SECTION 8. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after publication after final passage.
