Jansen shall recover from Defendants Gary Patel ("Patel") and Kusum

the per diem rate of \$33.44 from December 7, 2010, through the date of entry of this Judgment, and post-judgment interest at the rate(s) specified in 28 U.S.C. § 1961.

2. Jansen is entitled to a mechanic's lien under Utah Code Ann. § 38-1-1 et seq. in the amount of \$101,721.04, plus pre-judgment interest at the per diem rate of \$33.44 from December 7, 2010, through the date of entry of judgment, plus post-judgment interest at the rate(s) specified in 28 U.S.C. § 1961, plus attorneys' fees and costs in the amount of \$5,883.50. The lien is attached to, and shall be foreclosed against, that certain real property, which property is more particularly described as:

LOT 2, PLAT B, SUMMIT GROUP INC. SUBDV. AREA 1,472 AC.

and by this reference incorporated herein (the "Subject Property"). The Subject Property shall be sold at public auction by the Sheriff of Utah County, Utah in the manner prescribed by law for such sales. The person submitting the highest bid and upon payment of said bid amount to the Sheriff, shall be provided the Sheriff's Certificate of Sale and Sheriff's Deed.
