Located on grantor's land at a point 1,015 ft. north and 850 ft. west, more or less, from the southeast corner of Sec. 5, T. 3 N., R. 1 W., S. L. B. & M., and being in the SE 1/4 said Sec. 5.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.
