WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City, Utah, hasbeen deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20, 1862, To Secure Homesteads to Actual Setters on the Public Domain, and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Arthur Birch has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the North half and the southwest quarter of Section fourteen in Township two north of Range four east of the Salt Lake Meridian, Utah, containing four hundred eighty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor- General;
