WHEREAS, GRANTSVILLE SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT TOOELE

of the County of TOOELE State of UTAH heretofore purchased from the State of Utah, the lands hereinafter described, pursuant to the laws of said State in such case made and provided,

AND WHEREAS, the said GRANTSVILLE SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT

has paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale, and the laws of the State duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-Six and no/100 (\$2,226.40) Dollars, and all legal interest thereon accrued, as fully appears by the certificate of the proper officer, now on file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Utah;

NOW THEREFORE, I SCOTT M. MATHESON, Governor, in consideration of the premises, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, in such case made and provided, do issue this PATENT, in the name and by the authority of the State of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said GRANTSVILLE SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT

its and to its assignees

forever, the following tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of TOOELE State aforesaid, to-wit: Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Three (3); North Half (N 1/2) of Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4)

of Section Ten (10), Township Three (3) South, Range Five (5) West; North Half (N 1/2) of Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section Twenty-one (21), Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Twenty-two (22) and North

Half (N 1/2) of Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township Three (3) South, Range

Six (6) West, Salt Lake Meridian. Subject to all existing rights of record.

Reserving to the State of Utah, all coal and other minerals, in the above lands, and to it, or persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine and remove therefrom coal, oil, gas, uranium, and other minerals. Right of way, jet, sands, fishes, tunnels, telephone, and transmission lines constructed by authority of the United States are hereby reserved. U. S. Act, Aug. 30, 1890, 26 Stat. 351, 352, 353.
