DEDICATION.

We, the undersigned owners of the lands shown on the annexed plat, and named NEVADA ADDITION to and in Ogden City, Utah, do hereby dedicate, grant and convey unto Ogden City Corporation all those parts or portions of said lands (shown on the annexed plat and within the portion shaded with a red shade line) that are shown thereon as Streets and Avenues, the same to be set apart and used as public thoroughfares forever.

The parts or portions shown as Alleys on said plat are to be used in common by and for the benefit and convenience of any and all persons owning or occupying any lot or lots or portion thereof.

The said NEVADA ADDITION includes parts of Lots 6-7 and 8, of Block 7, Five Acre Plat A, Ogden City Survey, as shown on said plat; the lands owned by the undersigned being as follows: By Emanuel and Carrie E. Bowser, all of Lots 6 and 7, excepting the right of way of the Oregon Short Line Railway, and the part West and South of same, and by George T. and Florence C. Odell and Annie S. Wright, all of Lot 8, all in Block 7, Five Acre Plat A, as aforesaid.

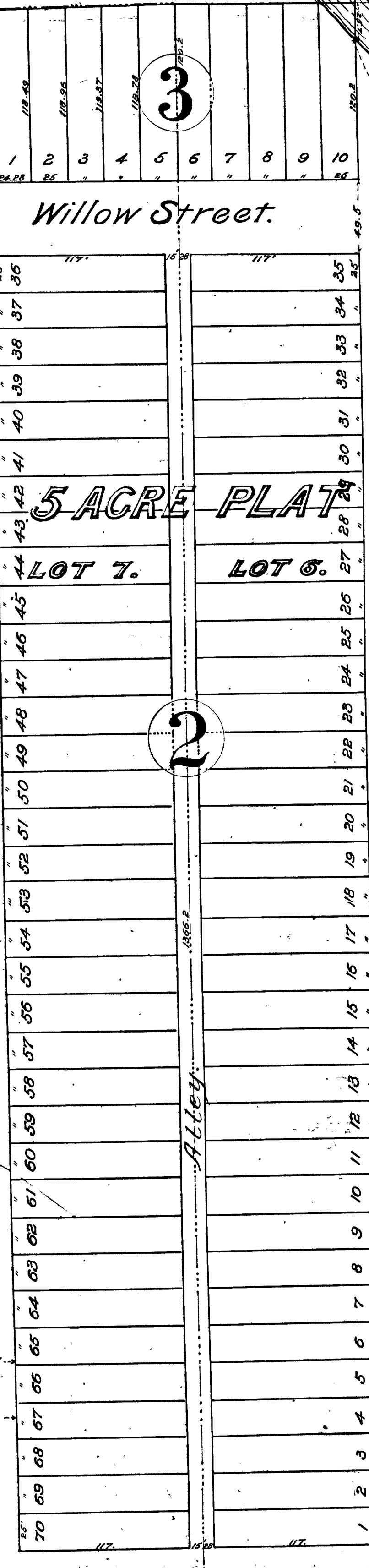
