

CONVEYANCE OF PROPERTY AND EASEMENT

The Herriman Irrigation Company of Herriman, Salt Lake County, Utah, Grantor, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby convey and warrant to the Utah Water and Power Board, Grantee, the following:

1. All of its entitled rights to the use of water flowing from Butterfield Canyon Creek, which issues from the Oquirrh Range one and one-half mile west of Herriman and drains an area of twelve square miles in Salt Lake County, the point of issuance from Butterfield Canyon lying 2100 ft. S. and 600 ft. W. of the Sw., Corner of Section 34, T3S., R2W., Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

2. An easement to the full use of the Irrigation Company's distribution system from Butterfield Canyon Creek by which means all the land of the Grantor and its stockholders are irrigated; the irrigation system being located in Section 25, 26, 27, 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36, of T3S., R2W., Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

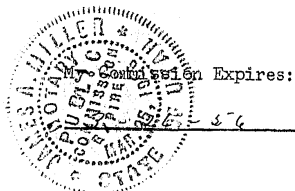
