For and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Thirty-nine Dollars and fifty cents (\$139.50), to be paid to the Grantors by the Grantee upon the acceptance of this instrument, we, William Knighton, Doris A. C. Knighton, ~~John T. Knighton~~ and Elizabeth Jane Knighton, Grantors, hereby grant and convey to the United States of America, Grantee, its assigns and successors, an easement to construct, operate, maintain, repair, or replace pipe lines and appurtenances for the conveyance of sewage from or under a portion of the land owned by the Grantors, situated in the County of Davis, State of Utah, more particularly described as follows:

A strip of land twenty (20) feet wide, the side lines of which are projected to the boundaries of the lands of the Grantors, the center line of which is described as follows:

Beginning at a point 35.0 feet North and 33 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 33, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, and running North 41 degrees, 14 minutes West 1277.5 feet, across the land of the said Grantor, and containing 0.59 acres.
