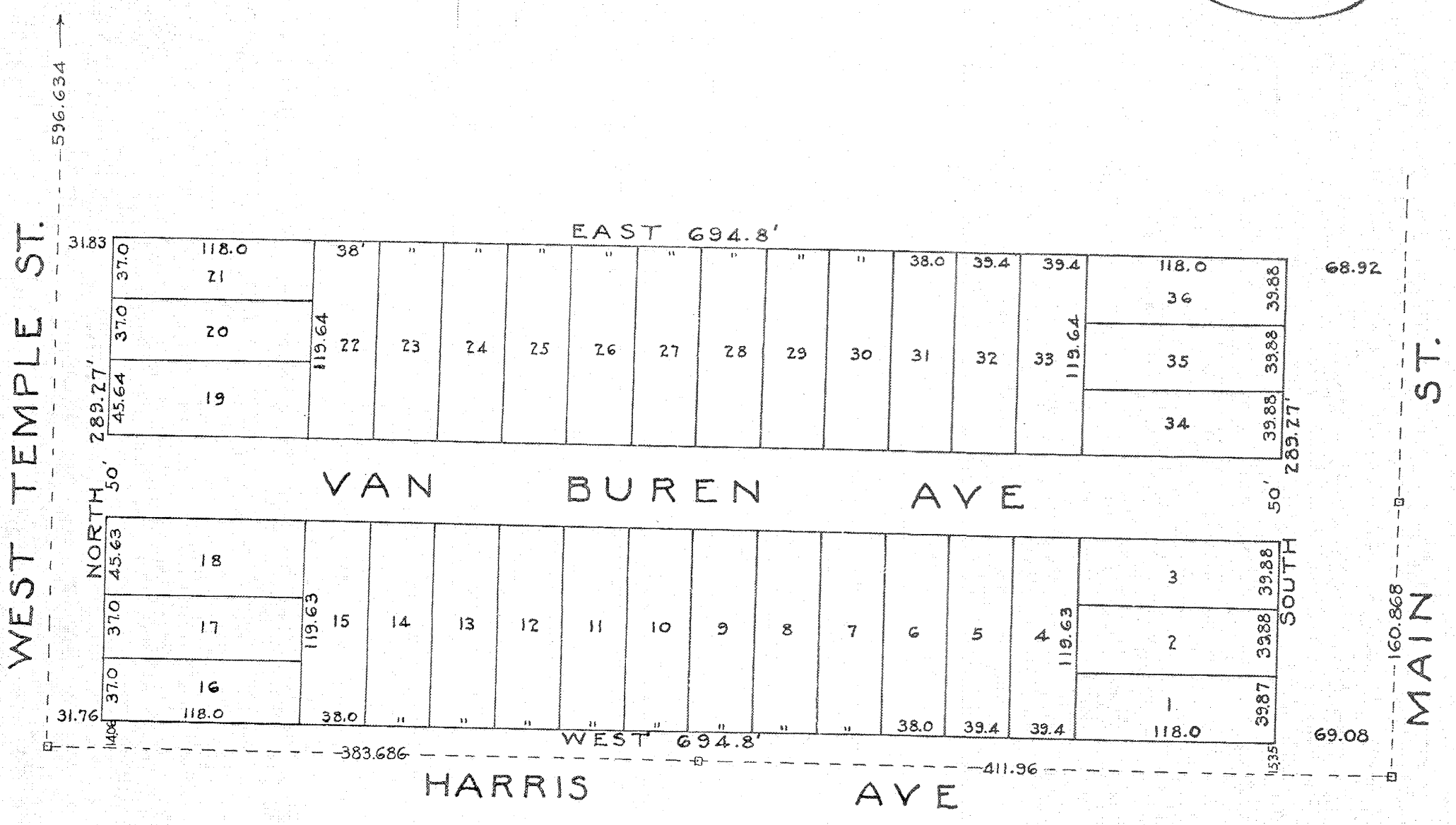


HERRICK SUBDIVISION

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE.

I hereby certify that this tract of land shown on this map and owned by Herrick and Company is bounded and described as follows to wit: Beginning at the North-West corner of lot 4, block 11, 5 Acre Plat A, Big Field Survey, running thence South 289.27 feet & thence East 694.8 feet, thence North 289.27 feet, thence West 694.8 feet to the place of beginning containing 4.614 Acres, and known as all of lot 4 Block 11 5 Acre Plat A, Big Field Survey, that I have by authority of the said owners thereof subdivided the same into an avenue and lots to be known as HERRICK SUBDIVISION. that the street lines have been accurately staked out on the ground as represented hereon, and that the steel tape used in making the survey was tested at the time in accordance with the provisions of the Revised Ordinances of 1920 and was in adjustment with the official standard prescribed in said ordinances.
