hereby Quit-Claim to Salt Lake County, grantee, for the sum of one

00 Dollars, a perpetual right-of-way

over and across the following described tract of land in Salt Lake County, State of Utah:

Commencing at a point 2403.2 feet S. 20° 19' E. of the N. W. corner of Section 5, T. 3 S., R. 3 E., Salt Lake Base and Meridian (point also bears S. 25° 18' W., 1162.0 feet from U. S. Mineral Monument No. 4, Little Cottonwood Mining District), point being on the south boundary of grantor's land, which is also the south boundary of Dwyer No. 4 claim, Survey No. 5189, thence running N. 62° 06' W. 756.0 feet to the boundary between Dwyer No. 4 claim and Dwyer claim, Survey No. 5189, thence N. 62° 06' W. 286.5 feet, thence N. 65° 07' W. 50.0 feet, thence N. 66° 46' W. 50.0 feet, thence N. 68° 40' W. 50.0 feet, thence N. 69° 55' W. 50.0 feet, more or less to a point in present Little Cottonwood surfaced highway containing 1.882 acres, more or less.

Right-of-way to be 66 feet wide extending 33 feet on each side of the center line as now surveyed and particularly described above.
