Ray J. Dawson and wife Mary B. Dawson grantors of Layton, Utah, County of Davis State of Utah, hereby grant bargain and sell to the STATE ROAD COMMISSION OF UTAH, Grantee for the sum of Three Hundred and Forty-eight (\$348.00) DOLLARS, the following described strip or parcel of land, as a perpetual right of way for highway purposes across the grantors land in Davis County, State of Utah, as follows:

Right of way for highway known as F. A. Project No. 59 across the grantors land in the S $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, T. 4 N., R. 1 W., S.L.M. Said right of way is contained within a parcel of land 60.0 ft. wide on the southwesterly side of the center line of survey of said project. From the south line of said Section 17, (Engineer's Station 57+26) to Engineer's Station 68+91.4 thence decreasing in width along a straight line to 50 ft. wide on said southwesterly side of the center line of survey at Engineer's Station 70+29.4. Said center line is described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the south line of said Section 17, and said center line of survey at Engineer's Station 57+26, which point is approximately 660 ft. westerly along said south section line, from the south  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 17, thence northwesterly 1263.6 ft. along the arc of a 1° 00' Curve to the left to Engineer's Station 69+89.6 back, which equals 69+91.6 ahead (Note: Tangent to said curve at the point of beginning bears N. 38° 37' W.); thence N. 51° 15' W., 37.8 ft to Engineer's Station 70+29.4 on said center line of survey, which point is 925 ft. south along the west line of said Section 17, and 1273.6 ft.
