TO ALL TO WHOME THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS Ike EDWARDS of Burnt Fork of the County of SWEETWATER State of Wyoming here-
torore purchases from the State of Utah, the lands hereinafter described, pursuant to the
laws of said State in such case made and provided,

AND WHEREAS, the said IKE EDWARDS has paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions
of said sale, and the laws of the State duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum of One
Hundred and Twenty (\$120.00) Dollars, and all legal interest, now on file in the office of
the Secretary of State of the State of Utah;

NOW, THEREFORE I WILLIAM SPRY, GOVERNOR, in consideration of the premises, and by v
virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, in such
case made and provided, do issue this PATENT, in the name and by the authority of the State
of Utah, hereby granted and confirming unto the said IKE EDWARDS and to his heirs and ass-
igns forever, the following piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of Uintan State
aforesand, to-wit:

The South Half (S-1/2) of the South West quarter (SW- 1/4) of Section Twenty-
two (22) in Township Three (3) North Range Seventeen (17) East of the Salt Lake Meri-
dian-containing Eighty (80) acres according to the said certificate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described and granted premises unto the said IKE
EDWARDS and to his heirs and assigns forever, subject to any easement or right of way of t
the public, to use all such highways as may have been established according to law, over
the same or any part thereof and subject also to all rights of way for ditches, tunnels, and t
telephone and transmission lines that may have been constructed by authority of the
United States.
