328822 TERMINATION OF THE COLAR ELEMENT

WHEREAS, the United States, Grantee, obtained a temporary easement from the Weber Basin Water Conservancy District, Grantor, during the construction of the Davis Aqueduct, Weber Basin Project, which easement was to be released when the construction work was completed through the easement area.

NOW, THEREFORE, the United States acting pursuant to the Act of Congress of June 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 388) having completed the construction work of the Davis Aqueduct and appurtenant structures through the certain easement area, does hereby release, terminate, and discharge the temporary easement obtained from the Grantor named in that certain deed dated September 24, 1954, and recorded in Book 73, Page 235, on the 28th day of October 1954, in the Davis County Recorder's Office and described as follows:

A strip of land in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW 1/4 SE 1/4) of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Four (4) North, Range One (1) West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, One Hundred Fifty-five (155.0) feet wide and included between two lines extended to the property lines and everywhere distant Ninety (90.0) feet on the right or Westerly side and Sixty-five (65.0) feet on the left or Easterly side of that portion of the following described centerline of what is known as the Davis Aqueduct from Station 377+28.6 to Station 380+35.9 measured at right angles thereto; said centerline is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at Station 377+28.6, a point on the North line of the Grantor's property, from which point the South Quarter corner of the said Section 36 hears South 2°46' West Nineteen Hundred Three and Four-tenths (1903.4) feet, and running thence South 25°32' East Three Hundred Seven and Three-tenths (307.3) feet to Station 380+35.9 of said Aqueduct centerline, a point on the South line of the Grantor's property, from which point the South Quarter corner of said Section 36 hears South 7°52' West Sixteen Hundred Thirty-nine and Two-tenths (1639.2) feet, containing 1.1 acres, more or less, excepting herefrom 0.3 of an acre, more or less, which is covered by a perpetual easement and described as follows:

A strip of land in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW 1/4 SE 1/4) of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Four (4) North, Range One (1) West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, Forty (40.0) feet wide and included between two lines extended to the property lines and everywhere distant Twentyfive (25.0) feet on the right or Westerly side and Fifteen (15.6) feet on the left or Emerging \$4. of that parties of the following described comparities of that is more us the Davis Aqueduct from Station Streets to treation Station Station

Beginning at Station 377+28.6, a point on the North line of the Grantor's property, from which point the South Quarter corner of said Section 36 bears South 2046' West Nineteen Hundred Three and Four-tenths (1903.4) feet, and running thence South 25932' East Three Hundred Seven and Three-tenths (307.3) feet to Station 380+35.9 of said Aqueduct centerline, a point on the South line of the Grantor's property, from which point the South Quarter corner of said Section 36 bears South 7052' West Sixteen Hundred Thirty-nine and Two-tenths (1639.2) feet.

This release shall not be construed to release or affect in any manner the perpetual easement granted by said Grantor in the above-referenced deed.
