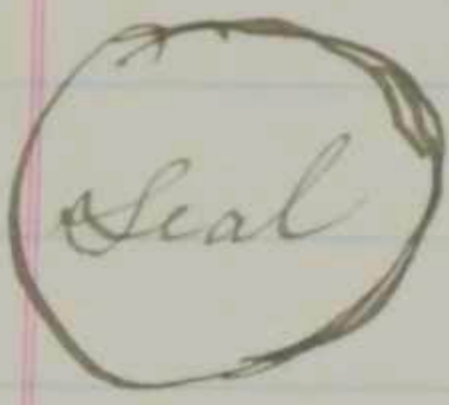

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land
 Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register
 of the Land Office at Salt Lake City Utah Territory, whereby
 it appears that, pursuant to the act of congress approved 20th
 May 1862 to secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public
 domain, and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Peter
 Shirts, has been established and duly consummated, in conformity
 to law for the South east quarter of Section twenty one
 in Township four South of Range twenty one east of Salt
 Lake Meridian Utah Territory containing one hundred
 and sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey
 of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by
 the Surveyor General; Now know ye, That there is, therefore,
 granted by the United States unto the said Peter Shirts
 the tract of land above described; To have and to hold the
 said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the
 said Peter Shirts and to his heirs and assigns forever;
 Subject to any vested and accrued water rights for Mining,
 agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights
 to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such
 water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the
 local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject
 to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and
 remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to
 penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided
 by law.

This Indenture, made the second day of May in the year of our Lord, one thousand, eight hundred and ninety Between Jacob R. Workman and his wife Maria a Workman of Vernal County of Uintah and Territory of Utah, parties of the first part, and Harvey C. Hullinger of the same place Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in Vernal Town Plat County of Uintah Territory of Utah, bounded and described as follows, to wit: Commencing at the North east corner of lot Two (2), in Block Twelve (12) Thence west on survey line Four (4) rods thence South parallel Thirteen (13) rods Thence east on survey line Four (4) rods, Thence North Thirteen (13) rods to place of beginning Said parcel of land is a portion of the North East Fourth $N\frac{1}{4}$ of South west one fourth $S.W\frac{1}{4}$ of Section twenty three (23) Township four (4) South of Range Twenty one (21) East Salt Lake Meridian containing Fifty two (52) square rods. Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, right of dower, property, possession, claim and demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity, of the party of the first part, of, in or to the said premises and every part and parcel thereof, with the
