Quit Blame Deed

George East, unmarried, grantor of Beacher Precinct Weber County, State of Utah hereby Quit Blains to and sells and convey to The Pioneer Electric Power Company a corporation of Utah its successors and assigns grantee of Ogden City, Weber County for the sum of sixty four (\$64⁰⁰) Dollars the following described tract of land in Weber County, State of Utah: A strip of land sixty feet in width and on each side of and contiguous to the center line of said companies canal as now constructed a strip of land 30 feet wide, and being 1320 feet more or less in length, bounded on the South by Section nine and north by John B. Wayments land containing two acres more or less, and being a part of the South East Quarter (14) of Section four (4) Township Six (6) North of Range three (3) West Salt Lake meridian and also hereby release said company and all persons acting under it from all claims for damages caused by reason of entering upon and constructing a canal on said premises and grant a right to enter upon and repair said canal on my premises also releases said company from all claims for a bridge over said canal.
