TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, JOHN McKINNEY of Fairfield of the County of Utah, State of Utah, heretofore purchased from the State of Utah, the Lands hereinafter described, pursuant to the laws of said State in such case made and provided,

AND WHEREAS, the said John McKinney has paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale, and the laws of the State duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum of Four Thousand Eight Hundred & no/100 (\$4800.00) Dollars and all legal interest thereon accrued, as fully appears by the certificate of the proper officer, now on file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Utah;

NOW THEREFORE, I, HARDEN BENNION, ACTING GOVERNOR in consideration of the premises, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, in such case made and provided, do issue this PATENT, in the name and by the authority of the State of Utah, hereby Granting and confirming unto the said John McKinney and to his heirs and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of Utah, State aforesaid, to wit:

The South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Fourteen (14); All of Section fifteen (15); the East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Twenty-one (21), and all of Section Twenty-two (22) in Township Seven (7) South, Range Two (2) West of the Salt Lake Meridian, containing nineteen hundred Twenty (1920) acres according to the said certificate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described and granted premises unto the said John McKinney and to his heirs and assigns forever, subject to any easement or right of way as may have been established or acquired according to law, over the same or any part thereof and subject also to all rights of way for ditches, tunnels, and telepone and transmission lines that may have been constructed by authority of the United States.
