acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land,
returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor-General:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the
premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case
made and provided, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND
GRANT, unto the said claimant and to the heirs of the said claimant the Tract
above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights,
privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto
belonging, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claim-
ant forever: subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining,
agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and res-
ervoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and
acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts; and there
is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches
or canals constructed by the authority of the United States; reserving also
to the United States, all coal in the lands so granted, and to it, or persons
authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine, and remove coal from the same
upon compliance with the conditions of and subject to the limitations of the Act
of June 22, 1910; (26 Stat., 583).
