with the right to prospect for, mine, and remove the same pursuant to the provisions and limitations of the Act of "ecember 29, 1916 (39 Stat., 862).

This entry is made under Section 28 of the Act of February 25, 1920 (41 Stat. 437) and the patent is issued subject to the rights of prior permittees or lessees to use so much of the surface of said lands as is required for mining operations, without comensation to the patentee for damages resulting from proper mining operations.
